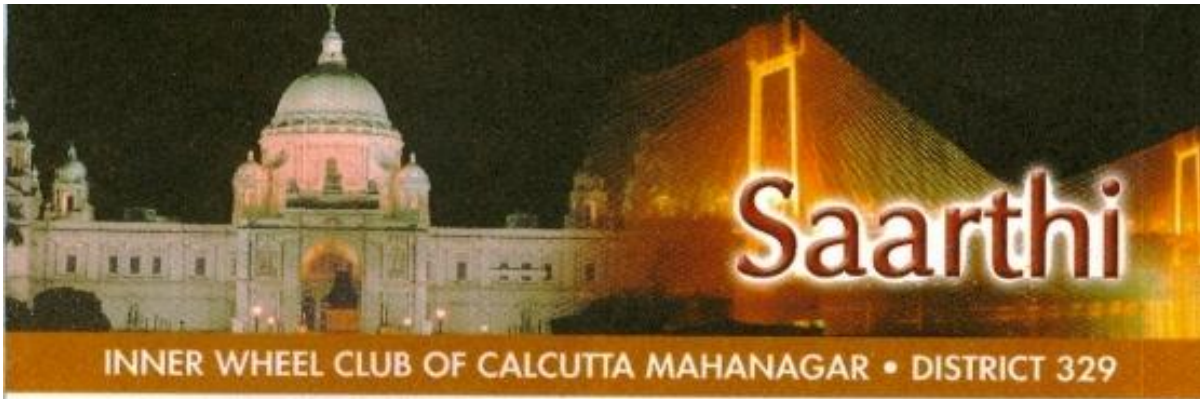
The festival of colours HOLI is on its way, spread the colours of happiness and replace the dull colours of sorrow with the colours of joy. HAPPY HOLI.
